Dear Practitioners & Practitioners-in-training,

It seems that every year there is some confusion about the Guild membership so I am sending it separately from the ***Stay in TTouch*** newsletter and hopefully this will simplify things.

Who needs to respond?

Any practitioners or practitioners-in-training who wish to be part of the TTouch Guild and take advantage of the benefits of being a Guild member. Why join the Guild?

Being a Guild member entitles you to:

- Free subscription to TTEAM Connections
- Free Practitioner newsletter—Stay in TTouch
- Discount on equipment (**only** practitioners who are current Guild members are eligible for discounts)
- Assist at horse or companion animal trainings - which count toward upgrading & updating
- Listing on the TTouch/TTEAM website (P-i-T's eligible after four trainings with completed case studies)
- Practitioner's workshops listings on the website
- Updated teaching materials from the internet.
- Referrals to people calling or writing the office
- Receive extra copies of TTEAM Connections to hand out to clients or at workshops

What about PiT's who have not graduated?

If you have attended 4 trainings; have fulfilled the case study requirement and are up-to-date in your payment schedule then your Guild Membership is included in your training. The January after you have graduated you will need to pay to remain in the Guild.

Maintaining Status

To maintain your current status practitioners will have to update every two years by attending ONE of the following:

- a) the 2009 Celebration in November
- b) a TTRACT/TTEAM training (minimum 5 days) - may do so by assisting if you are current

(if you are not current you may attend as a student for 1/2 the workshop price)

- c) by attending an Advanced Training or 3-Day Practitioner Update

We are offering 3-day Practitioner updates for TTRACT Practitioners. If you would like to

organize one contact me.

If you haven't managed to update you will still be eligible to join the Guild. On the website we will list the year that the Practitioner graduated and when they last assisted or updated. That way people looking for a practitioner will know how current a practitioner is and those of you who are still actively using the work but have not been able to attend an update will still have the benefits of the Guild membership.

To take advantage of the Early Bird 20% discount you must send this in by January 31st, 2010.

If we do not hear from you we will assume that you do not wish to be listed. We do not want to list practitioners who are **not interested** in working with clients or teaching workshops. If you do not wish to be referred to individuals please mark the appropriate place on the enclosed form.

On the enclosed form write the year you graduated from the TTACT Program and the number of workshops you have assisted at (you must have assisted for at least 5 days for a session to count towards assisting) or the year of your last Advanced Training. For TTEAM Practitioners please list the year you became a Practitioner (if you can remember) and date of last update.

If paying the fee is a problem right now please send in your form and contact us to arrange a payment plan. I do not want to drop anyone who wants to join the Guild but need you to respond in a timely manner. If you do not wish to join the Guild at this time and/or would like to be taken off the mailing list - please check that option and send it back to me - that way I know that people have not simply forgotten. If you would still like to receive TTEAM Connections newsletter there is an option on the form to just get the newsletter.
